Presentation Options

Course Counselling Sessions

15 minutes each

- Year 10 12
- One-on-one course counselling sessions at your school to discuss course information and pathways

allow for a minimum of 3 hours

- All year groups
- Held on Murdoch University's South Street campus
- Small groups to whole cohorts, for both local and regional schools
- Bespoke visits tailored to your students' areas of interest and time available
- Can include campus tours, interactive activities, or presentations

recommended no longer than 4 hours

- All year groups
- We are available to attend school expos and parent information evenings
- We can send representatives from our team, as well as our Student Ambassadors, to share more about courses and pathways at Murdoch

Varied

- Year 9-12

- Ambassadors set up at tables around a room, allowing students to speak to the Ambassadors that align to their area of interest

minimum 30 mins recommended 60 mins

- Year 10 12
- Ask a selection of our current and past students about pathways, their university experience, and their advise for future students
- · Questions can be collection prior to the session for ease

- Our Ambassadors are able to deliver short presentations covering their course, pathway, and their student experience
- Time can be tailored depending on availability
